Organization

This meeting has been organized through a cooperative agreement between GPC (High Level Group of Crest) and EuroHORCs/ESF and is hosted by the Consejo Superior de Investigaciones Científicas (CSIC) as member of MICINN and EuroHORCs.

Aims of the meeting

The main goal of this meeting is to share the vision documents developed by the working groups of EuroHORCs/ESF and the FC (Framework Conditions) team of GPC concerning the guidelines for 4 of the 6 FC of the Joint Programming Initiative (JPI) (peer-review, forward looking, programme evaluation and funding cross-border research).

The development of the FC document is a specific mandate of the EU Council to the Crest-GPC to orient and harmonize the launching of JPIs. Therefore, this meeting should provide a list of the main principles and guidelines concerning the four above mentioned topics useful to configure the FC document.

Participants

The participants of this meeting will be experts involved in the elaboration of the guidelines of FC invited by GPC (MS, Associated Countries, Council and Commission), EuroHORCs and ESF. Experts of CSIC as host institution, but also as representative of MICINN and member of EuroHORCs will also participate. Representatives from other institutions would be also invited (ERC, ERA-Learn, EARTO, TAFTI, etc.).

The optimal number of participants is estimated to be not larger than 100 persons. In case this number could be exceeded we should introduce some limits to the number of participants by country.

The parallel sessions will have two chairs (GPC and EuroHORCs/ESF) that will introduce the debates by preparing short presentations of the topics. Each parallel session will have a rapporteur responsible for preparing the conclusions of each topic to be presented in the final common session.

Travel and accommodation costs will be borne by each expert or by their respective agencies or organizations.

How to arrive

The Central Campus of CSIC (Consejo Superior de Investigaciones Científicas) (www.csic.es) is located in the centre of Madrid in Serrano street number 117. From Barajas airport you can reach the central building of CSIC by subway/metro (lane 8 (Violet) (from Barajas station to Nuevos Ministerios station) and then by internal change (no additional cost) to lane 6 (Grey) from Nuevos Ministerios station to República Argentina station (2 €). You can also use a taxi that will take around 25 min from terminal 4 (approx. 30 €) and 20 min from terminals (1, 2 or 3) (approx. 25 €). There is also an Airport Bus but is not so convenient.

Hotels

We have arranged special prices for the attendants to this meeting at the hotel NH Abascal (10 min by walking to Central Campus of CSIC) (José Abascal 47, 28003 Madrid) (<http://www.nh-hoteles.es>), but there are many hotels near (walking distance) the Central Campus of CSIC. In addition, since the subway station of República Argentina is very close to the CSIC Campus any other hotel located near a subway station might be also appropriated.
