BACKGROUND

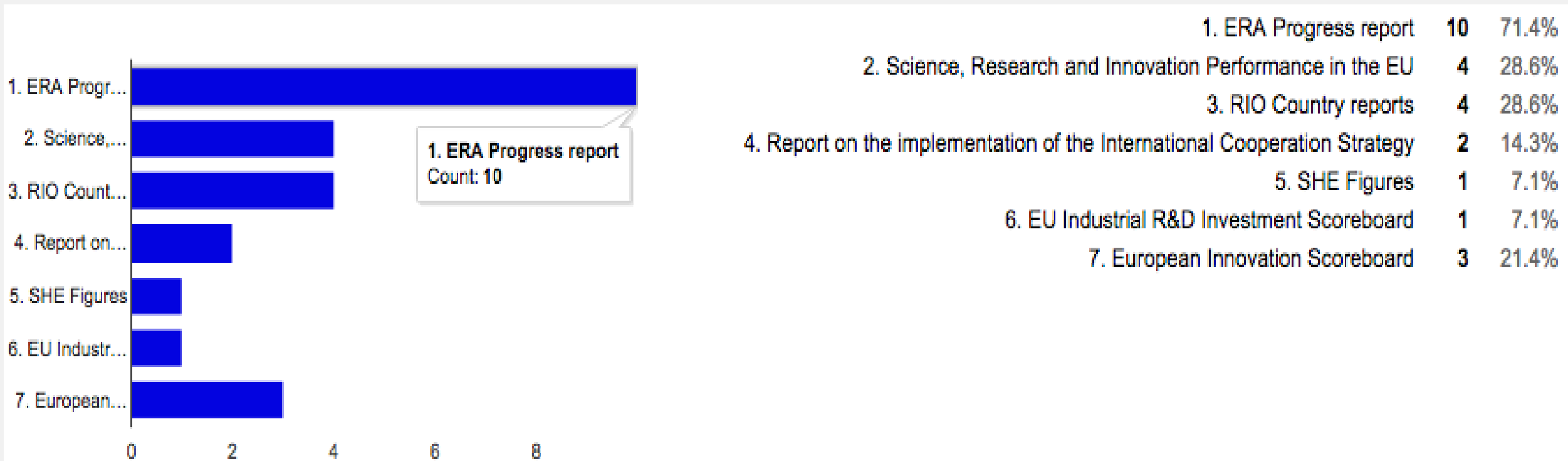
- In April 2014, an ERAC Opinion linked to the National Reform Programme process highlighted that the increasing burden on many Member States **calls for some streamlining of the various reporting exercise in the field of R&I**; ERAC provided also a recommendation for further discussions on the reporting burden and to propose solutions for its **alleviation**
- The November 2015 Council conclusions on the ERA Advisory Structure agree that more effort needs to be made to reduce added monitoring and reporting burden on the Member States and call upon a) the Commission and b) the ERA-related groups to **identify areas** where monitoring and administrative burdens of reporting may be reduced through further **streamlining**

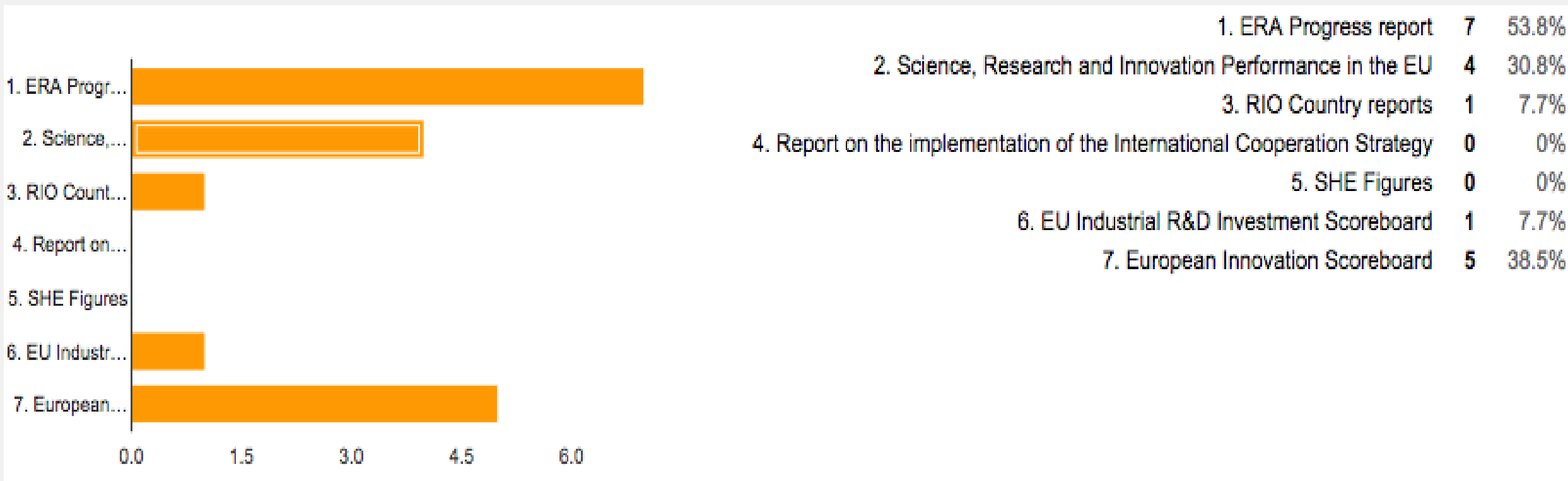

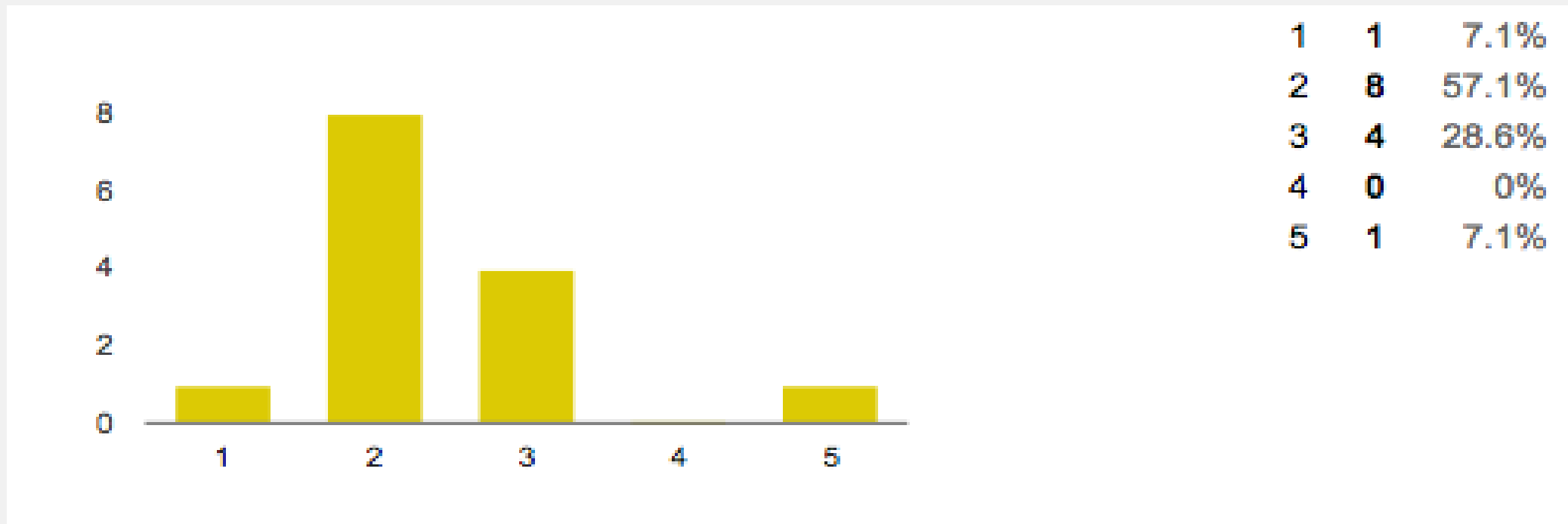

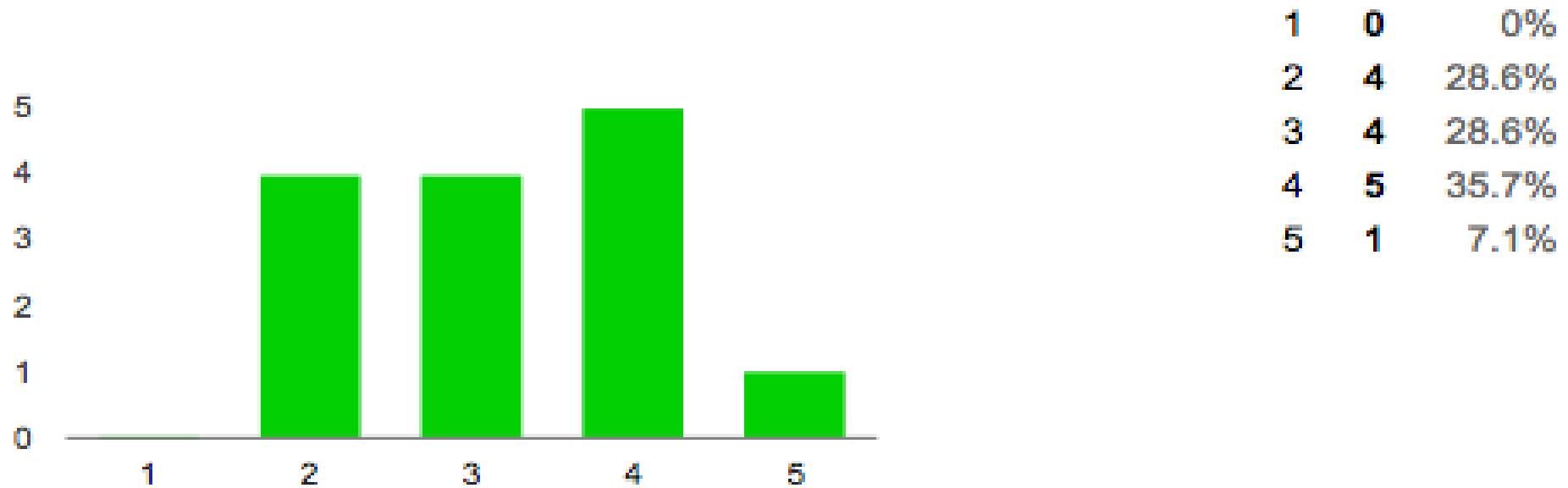

Preparation phase - collecting data/indicators



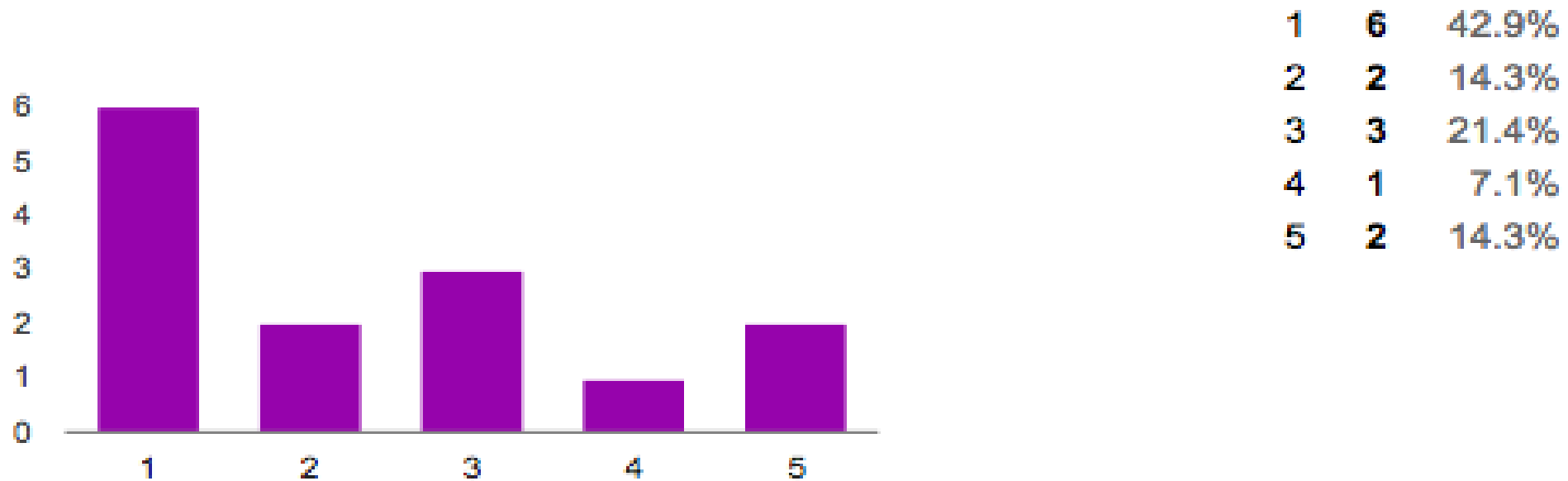

Preparation phase - finding information about previous periods or certain topics

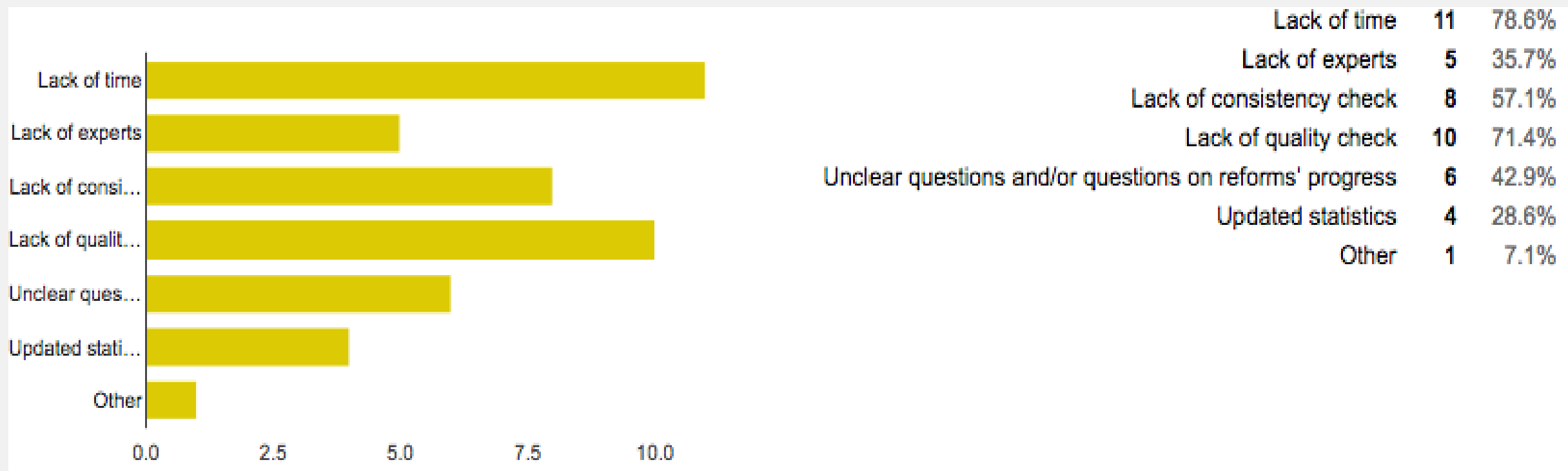

Allocating enough time and well-trained human resources to check consistency and eventually edit/ review draft reports

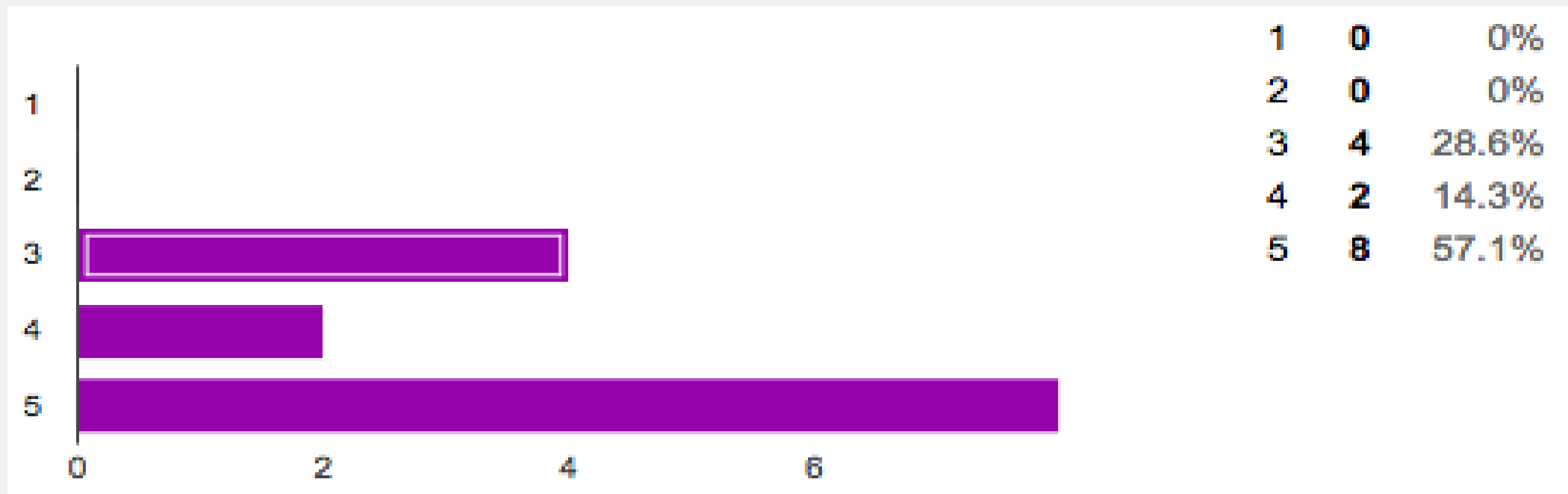

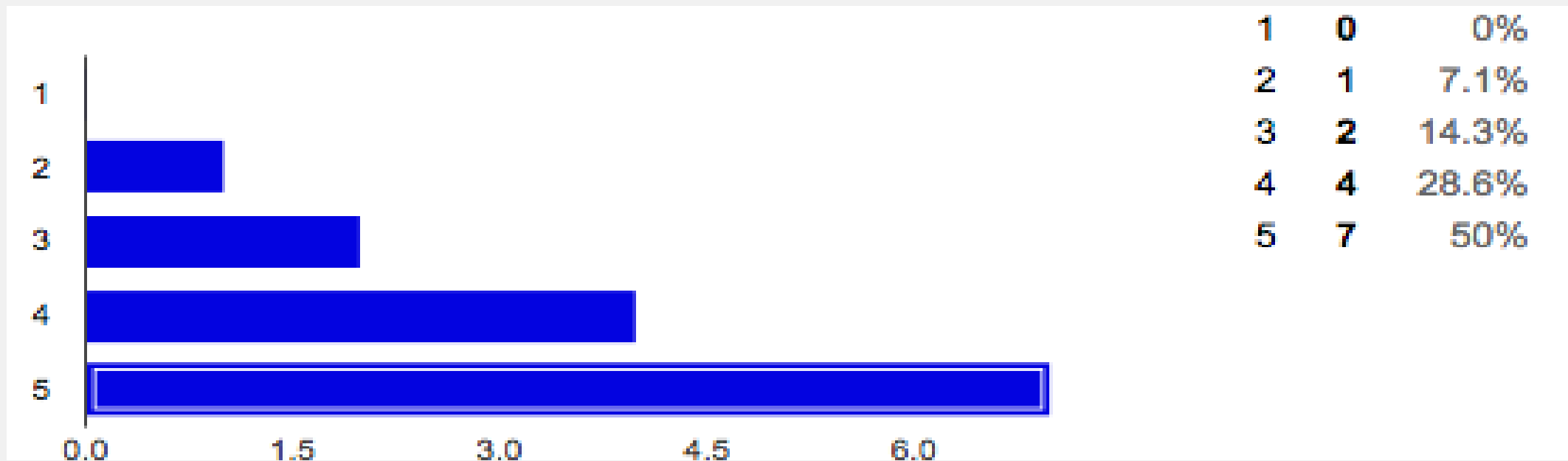

- The rationale for information requests should be clear ex-ante



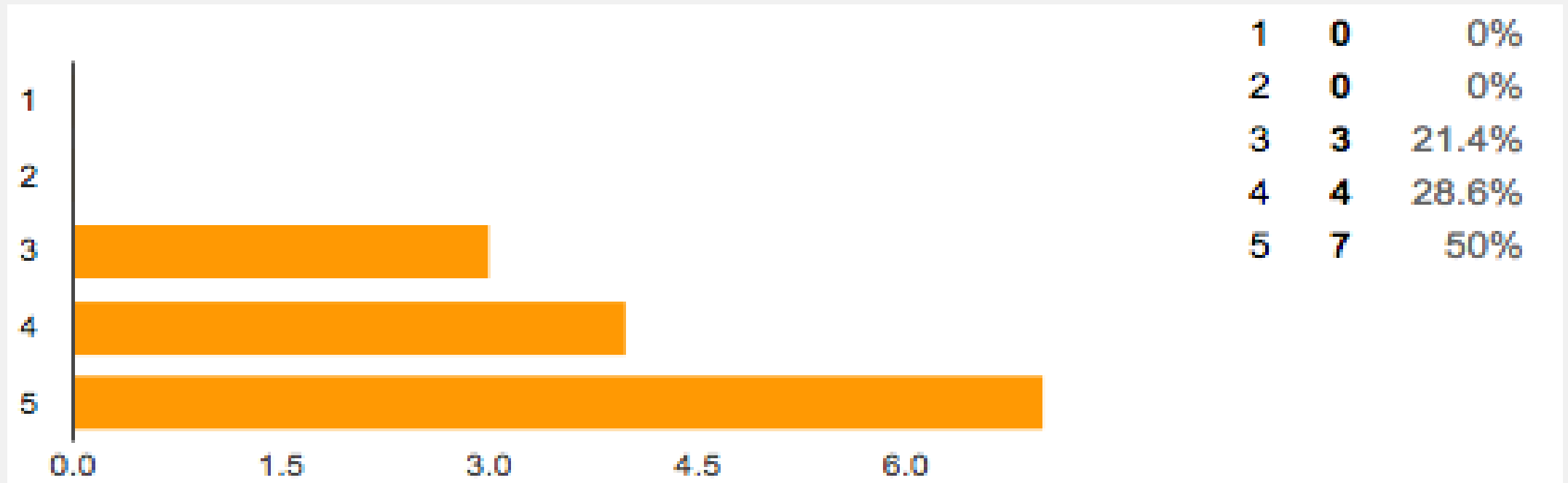

- The reporting flow within the Commission should be optimized



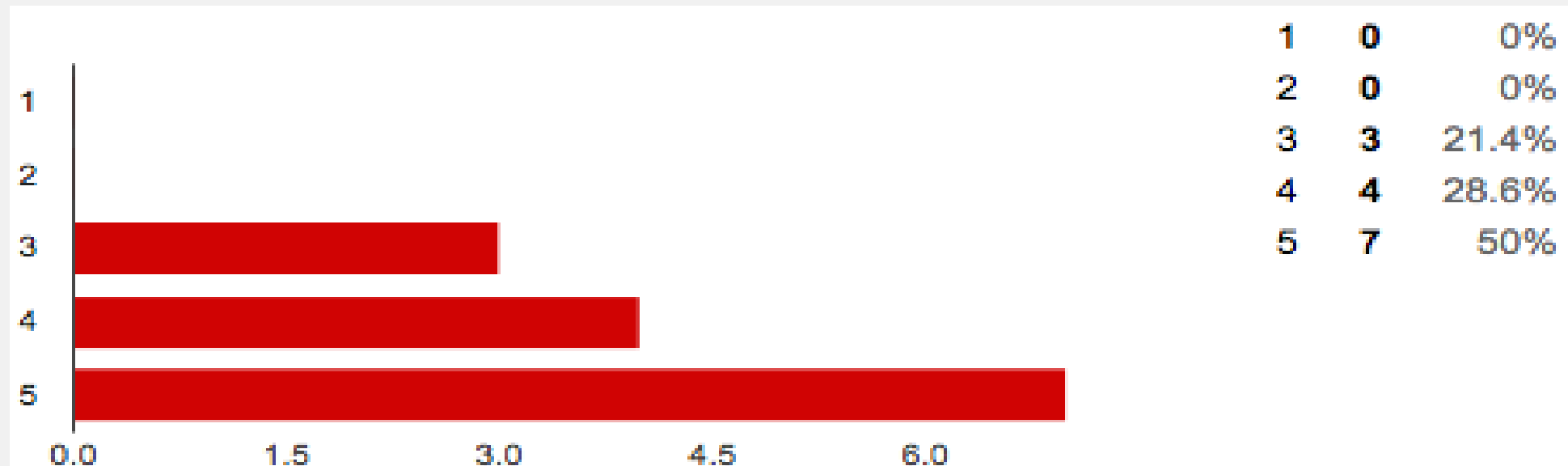

- Existing sources of information should be checked for consistency



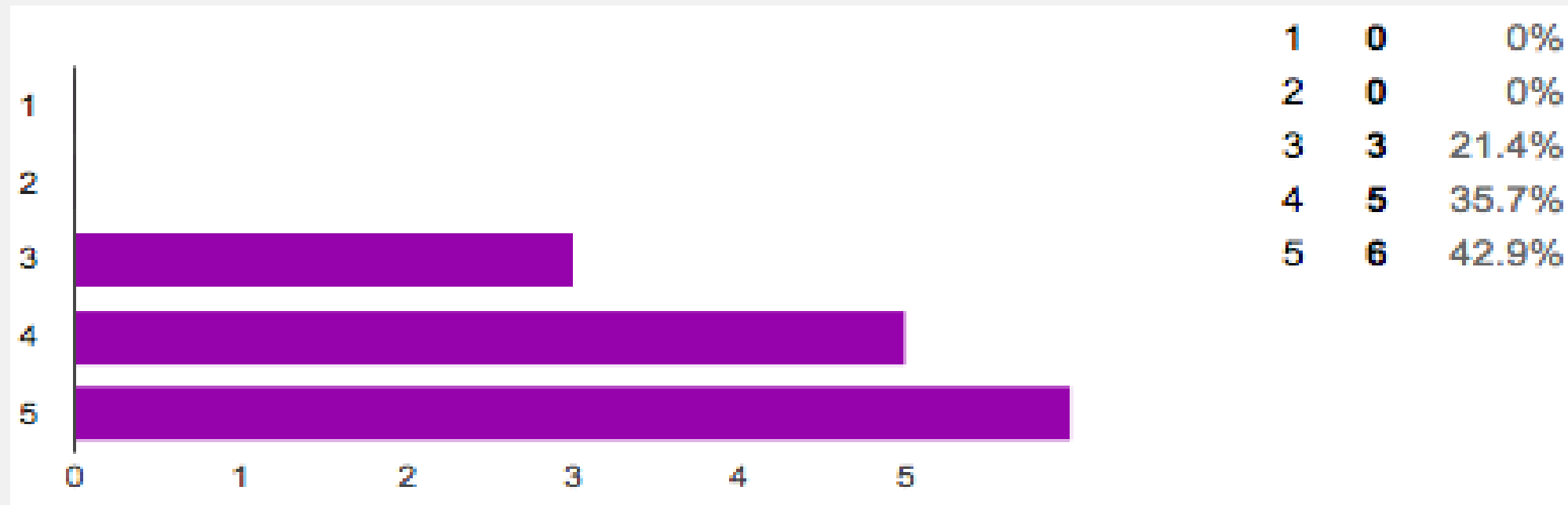

- Focus should be set on reports that are useful for policy practice



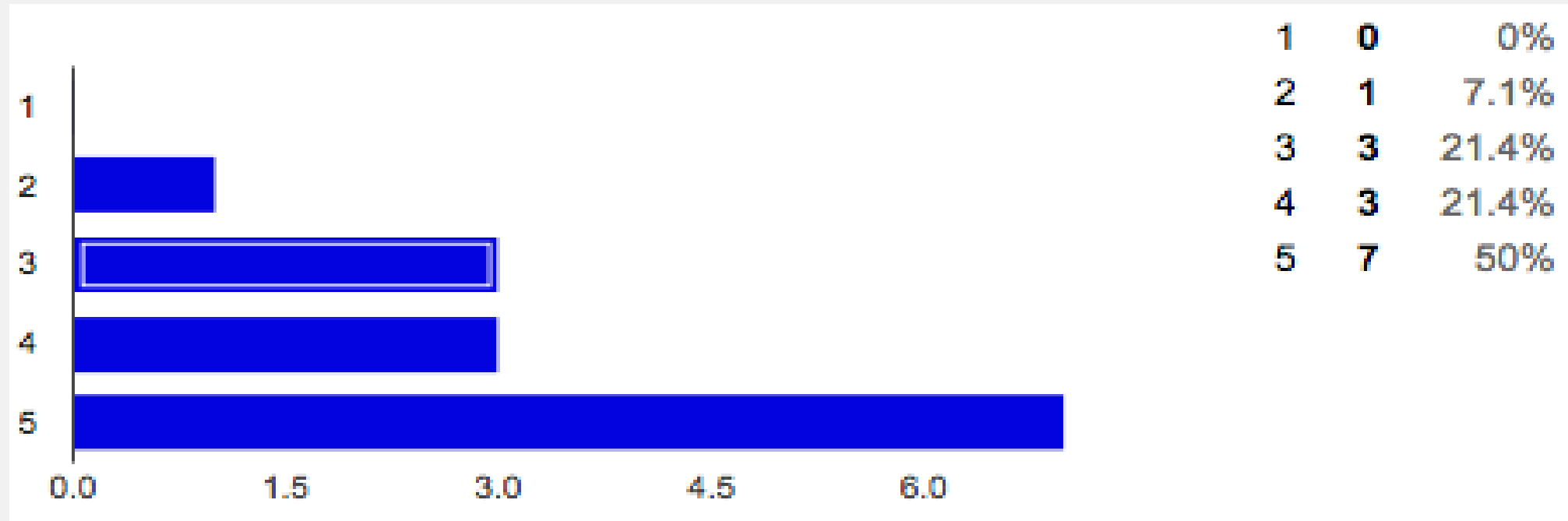

- Increased visibility and transparency



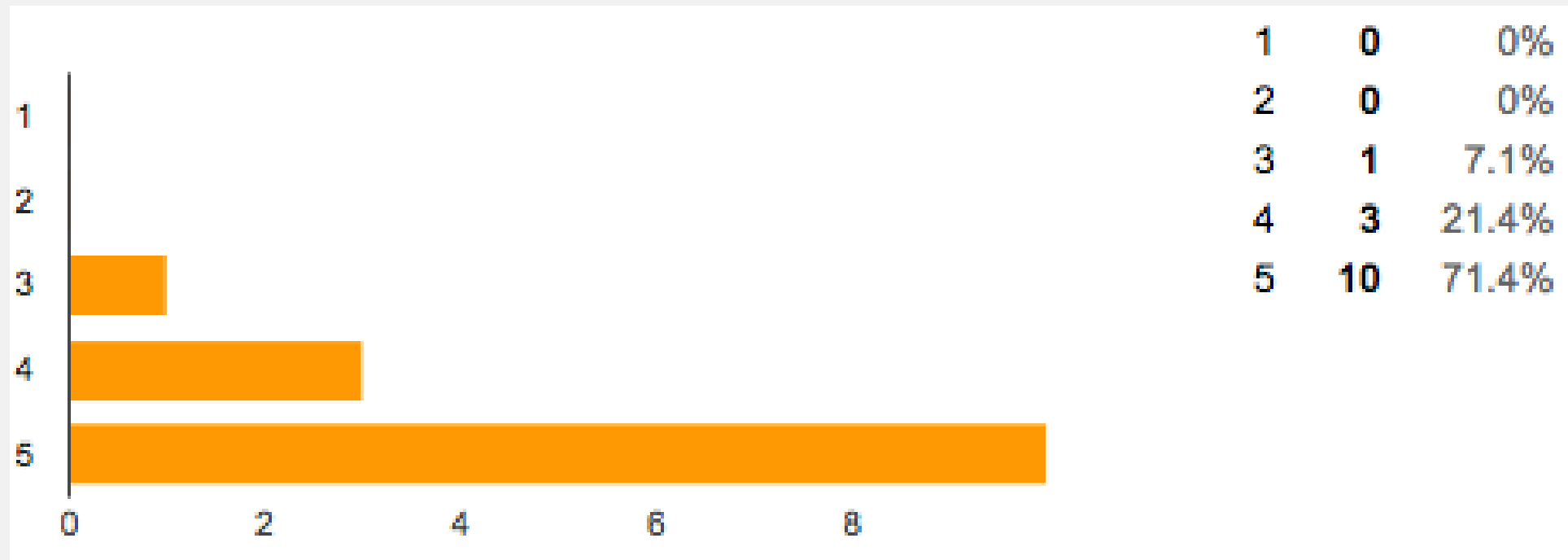

- Increased coherence among the reports



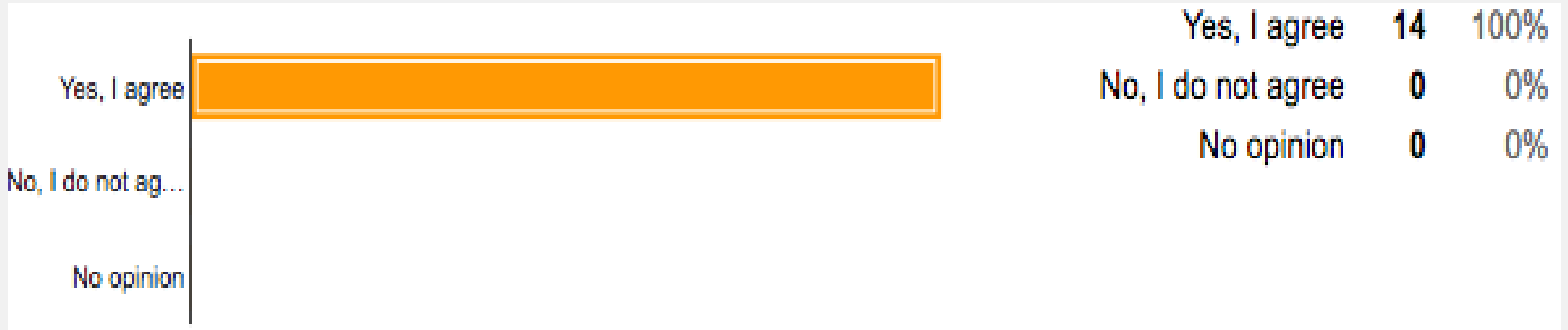
Q8. DO YOU AGREE OR NOT TO THE FOLLOWING PROPOSALS FOR INCREASED STREAMLINING:
